
St. Lewis Coastal Habitat Stewardship Agreement



The Town of St. Lewis and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a COASTAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT in November 2009, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

St. Peter's Bay Stewardship Zone lies approximately 30 km south of St. Lewis and stretches 5 km wide, with several small islands. It is an important nesting, moulting, and staging area for the common eider.
