Portugal Cove - St. Philip's Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement



The Town of Portugal Cove - St. Philip's and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a MUNICIPAL HABITAT **STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT in June 2015, committing to the** conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

Within a larger stewardship zone, the agreement designates the following 5 areas as protected areas, known as Management Units, totalling 2,106.8 acres (853 ha): Voisey's Brook, Blast Hole Ponds, Main River Gully, Beachy Cove Brook Gully and Broad Cove River Gully.
