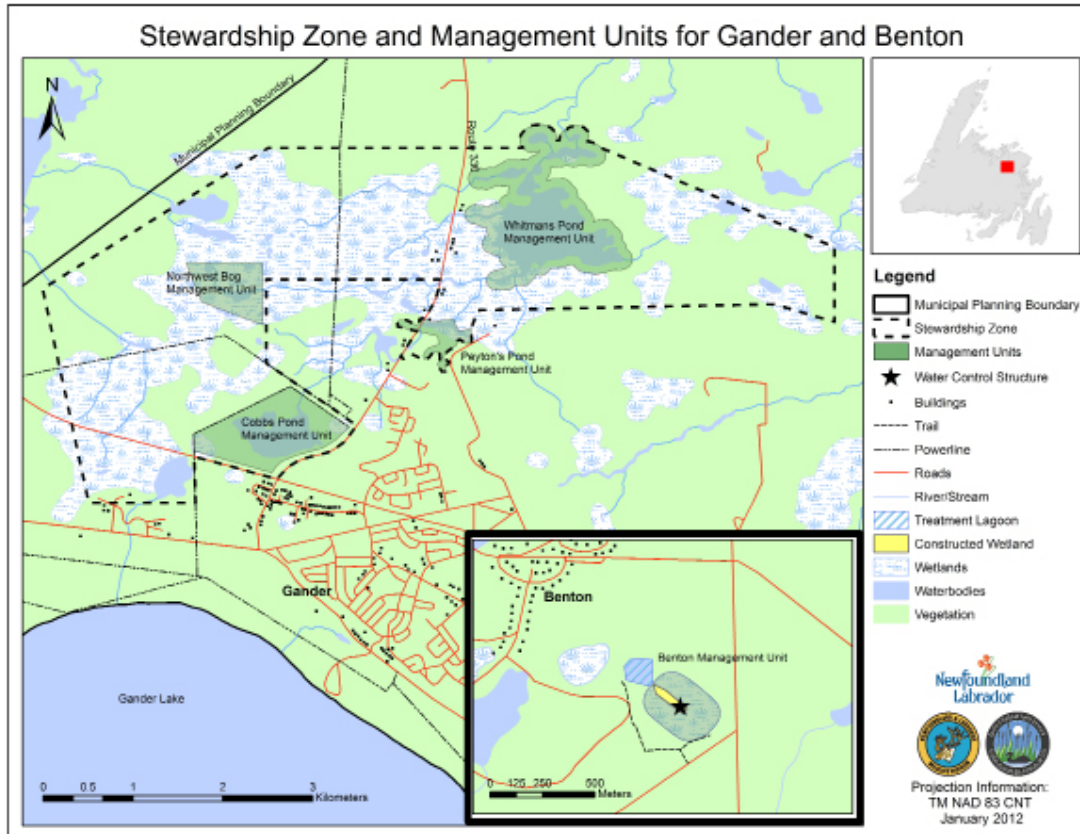


Gander Wetland Habitat Stewardship Agreement

The Town of Gander and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **WETLAND HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in June 1993, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.



Within a larger stewardship zone, the agreement designates the following 4 areas as protected areas, known as Management Units, totalling 873 acres: Northwest Bog, Cobb's Pond, Whitman's Pond and Peyton's Pond. The Benton Lagoon is a constructed sewage treatment wetland and is also included as a Management Unit.
