

# Channel - Port aux Basques Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement

The Town of Channel-Port aux Basques and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in August 2003, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the towns' planning boundaries.

Within a larger stewardship zone, the agreement designates 727 acres of wetland and coastal habitat as 3 Management Units: Shorts Pond, Big Barachois and Rocky Barachois. The Stewardship Zone contains formally designated critical habitat beaches that are used by breeding piping plover each year.

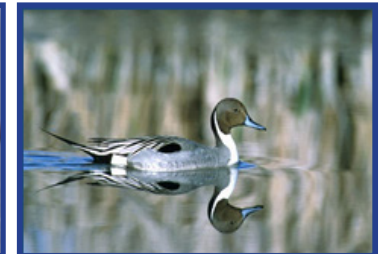
