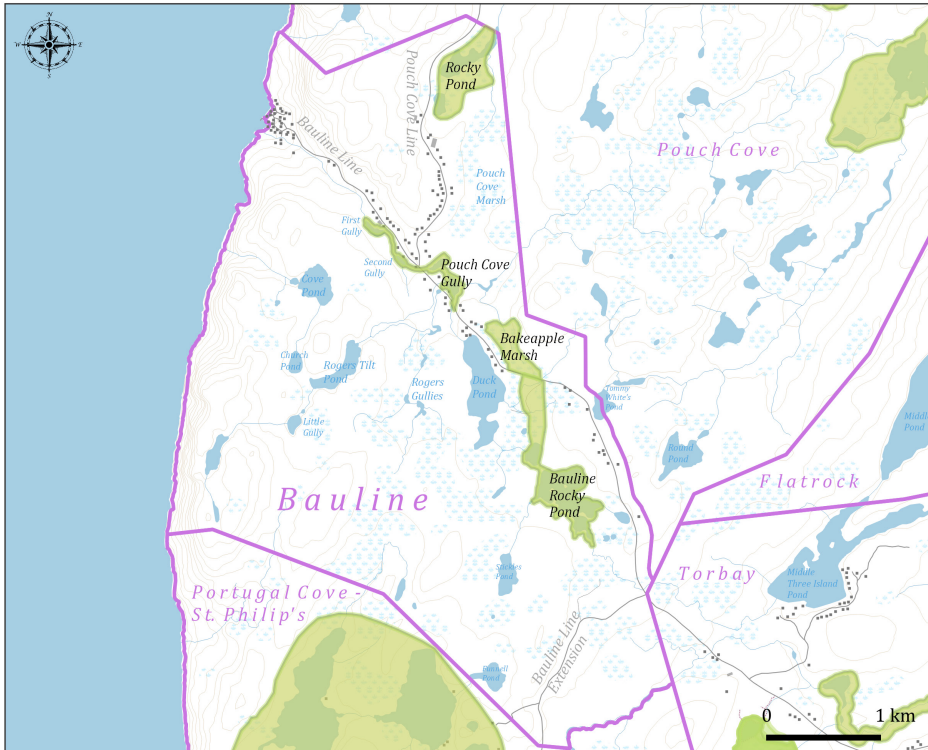


Bauline

Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement

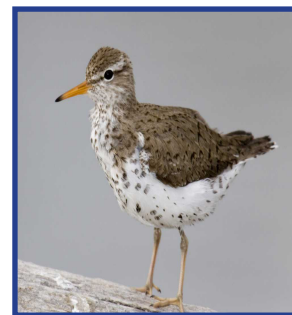
The Town of Bauline and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement** in 2015, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

The agreement designates the following 4 conservation areas, totalling 185 acres: Rocky Pond, Pouch Cove Gully, Bakeapple Marsh and Bauline Rocky Pond. These areas have excellent wetland and upland habitat for waterfowl, shore birds, and songbirds.



Bauline Rocky Pond

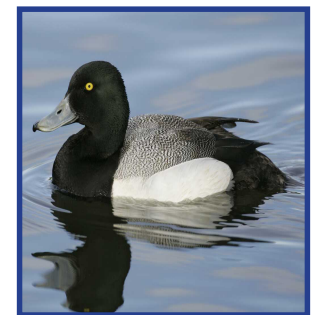

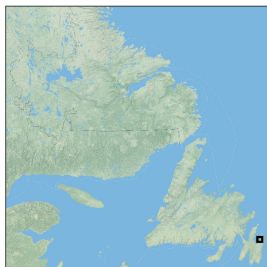
Spotted Sandpiper
