

The Town of St. Lawrence and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT in 2013, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

The area in the agreement follows the coastline along a 400 m buffer. This area, known to SAM as the St. Lawrence Coastline Management Unit, totals 1,542 acres and includes several harbours and coves such as Three Sticks Cove, Murphy's Cove, Little Lawn Pond, Mine Cove, Little Lawn Harbour, Spices Cove, and Chambers Cove.
