

Lewisporte Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement

The Town of Lewisporte and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in October 2017, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

The agreement designates Bottom Brook Estuary as the protected area, known as a Management Unit, totalling 58 hectares (143 acres). The mixing of salt and fresh water creates a highly productive environment, important for wildlife habitat.
