
Mary's Harbour Coastal Habitat Stewardship Agreement











The Town of Mary's Harbour and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a COASTAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT in November 2009, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

St. Peter's Bay Stewardship Zone lies approximately 25 km south of Mary's Harbour and stretches 5 km wide, with several small islands. It is an important nesting, moulting, and staging area for the common eider.
