## Deer Lake Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement The Town of Deer Lake and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador

The Town of Deer Lake and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT in June 2011, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

Within a larger stewardship zone, the agreement designates the following 3 areas as protected areas, known as Management Units, totalling 970 acres: Upper Humber River management unit, Junction Brook Bog and the Island.
