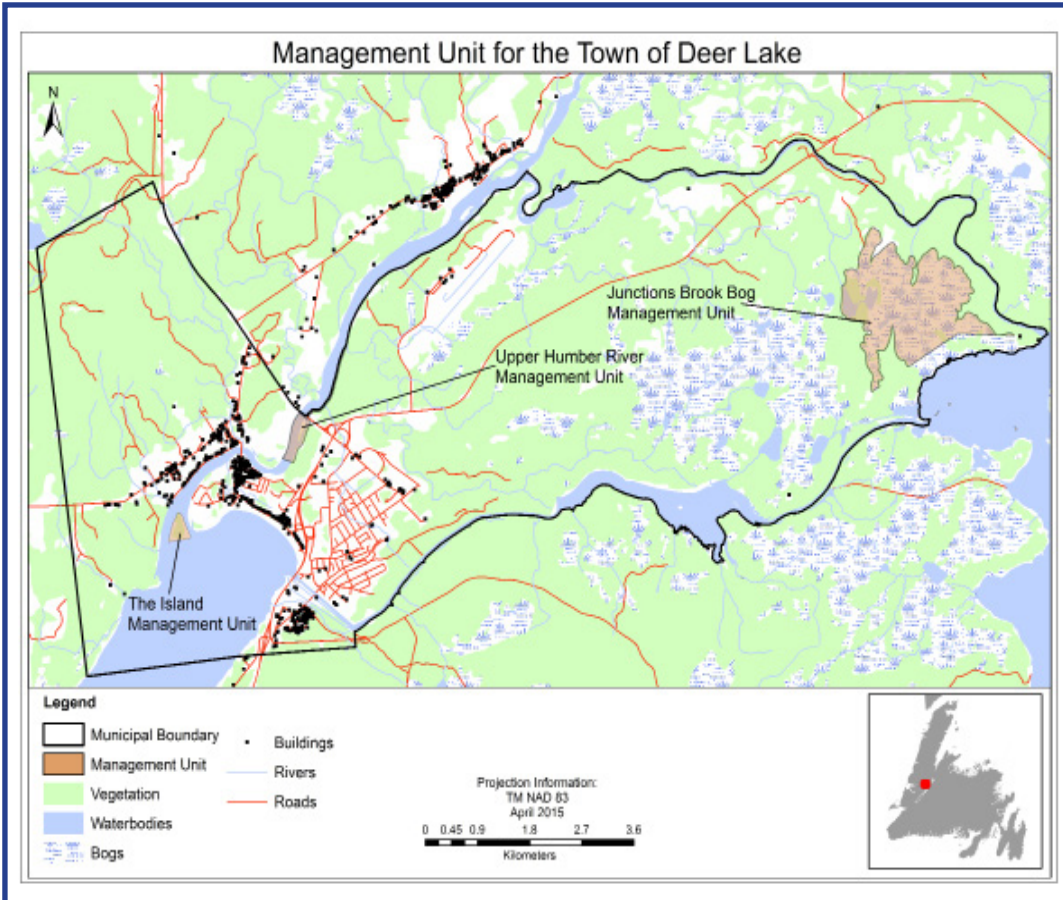


Deer Lake Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement

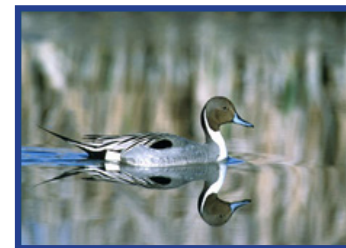
The Town of Deer Lake and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in June 2011, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

Within a larger stewardship zone, the agreement designates the following 3 areas as protected areas, known as Management Units, totalling 970 acres: Upper Humber River management unit, Junctions Brook Bog and the Island.

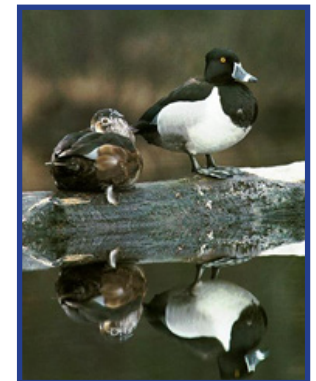
Upper Humber River Management Unit
