

Pouch Cove Municipal Habitat Stewardship Agreement

The Town of Pouch Cove and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **MUNICIPAL HABITAT STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in 2017, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

The agreement designates 6 protected areas, known as Conservation Areas, totalling 622 acres (251 ha). Along with excellent wetland and pond habitats, the unique steep coastline and rock cliffs provide habitat for many shore birds.
